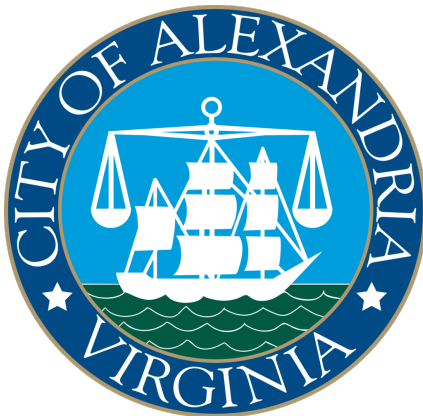
Last Mile Leadership Scholar: Ryan Varricchio

New Bipartisan Bill for Renewable Natural Gas

A new bipartisan bill has been introduced to the United States House and Senate. This bill would provide tax credits for renewable natural gas used for motor vehicle fuel. This bill is modeled after the Alternative



Fuels Tax Credit, includes certified blended RNG, and lists a \$1-per-gallon tax credit.
