VCC Talks: Energy Law with Sam Brumberg

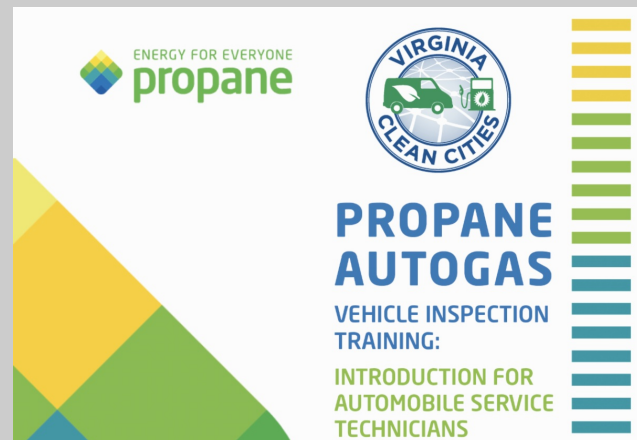

Propane Autogas Vehicle Inspection Training

Join technicians from the region at our inaugural Propane Autogas Vehicle Inspection Course. This course is a day-long operation at Virginia Clean Cities in response to a program launched by PERC in early 2024. 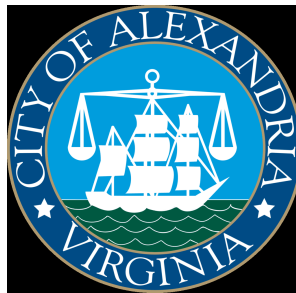
