Customer Control

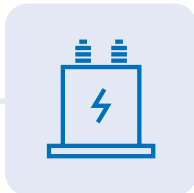
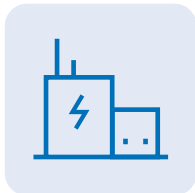
Participants have control to make decisions about their own charging operations.



Consulting and Technical Assistance

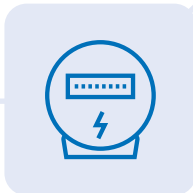
For Fleet customers, Dominion Energy offers no-cost fleet advisory services to help plan.

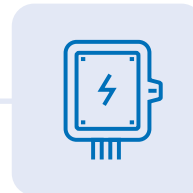

ELECTRIC METER

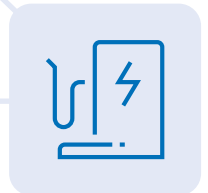


EV SUPPLY INFRASTRUCTURE (EVSU) OR "EV MAKE-READY"

How it Works

- After reviewing the program information, Terms and Conditions, and verifying the project site is in an Environmental Justice Community, Customers may submit an [online application](#).
- Dominion Energy will review applications and perform a desktop review of eligible sites. Selected applicants will be notified to confirm site design and charging equipment.
- Dominion Energy and the Customer will review and finalize the project proposal.
- The Customer signs and returns the project contract and agreements, confirms site readiness, and provides the property insurance certificate.
- Dominion Energy will install the charging infrastructure at no cost, and you can start charging!

Participation Requirements

- Available to Dominion Energy Virginia Commercial or Industrial customers located in an Environmental Justice Community as defined in [Virginia Code § 2.2-234](#). Review our program [Eligibility Guide](#) to determine if your site qualifies.
- Customers must install a minimum of two charging stations. Workplace, public, and multi-family customers must install Level 2 charging stations. Fleet customers may install Level 2 or Direct Current Fast Charging (DCFC) stations.
- Customers must use the program's licensed electricians for construction and installation of EV Supply Infrastructure (EVSU) and EV Supply Equipment (EVSE).
- Customers must agree to separately metered service from any other electric service at the site.
