EVCAP Announces 2nd Round of Funding



Virginia Energy has opened a new round of funding through the Electric Vehicle Charging Assistance Program (EVCAP) to support the deployment of electric vehicle charging infrastructure in underserved communities across the Commonwealth. The program is designed to increase access to electric vehicle supply equipment, address gaps in charging availability, and deliver measurable community benefits that support broader electric vehicle adoption.

Virginia Energy will make up to \$510,000 available through competitive subawards for eligible applicants—including for-profit businesses and government-industry partnerships—for the purchase and installation of EV charging equipment. Virginia Energy may partially fund proposals at its discretion, with projects expected to continue through December 2027.
