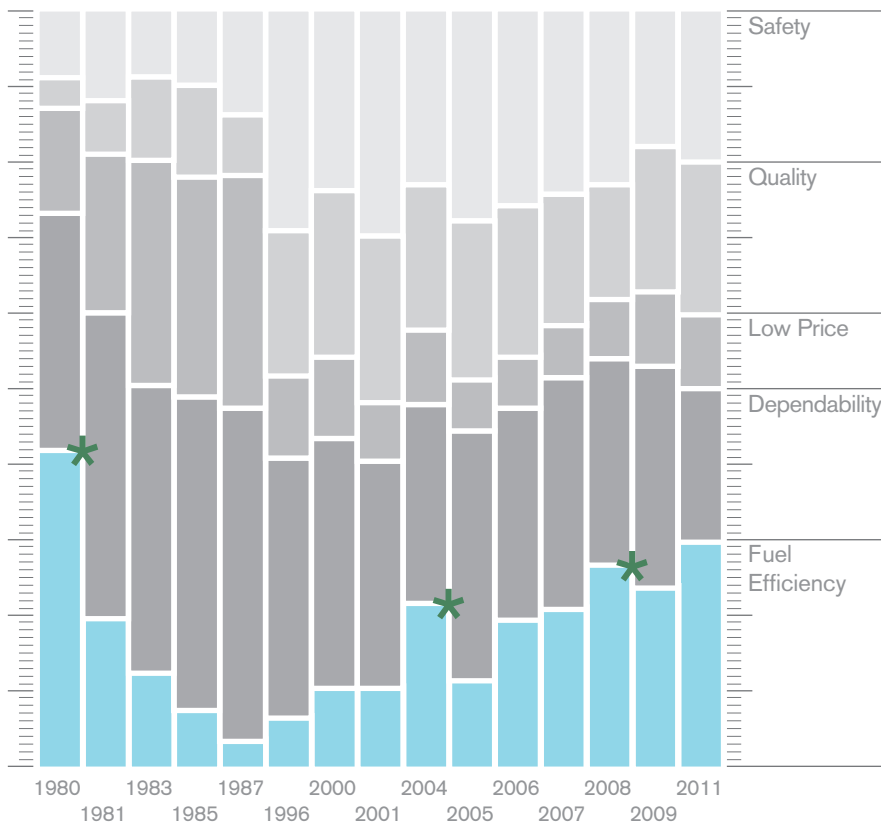

- *2008 - gasoline prices topped \$4.00 (\$4.20 adjusted for inflation)

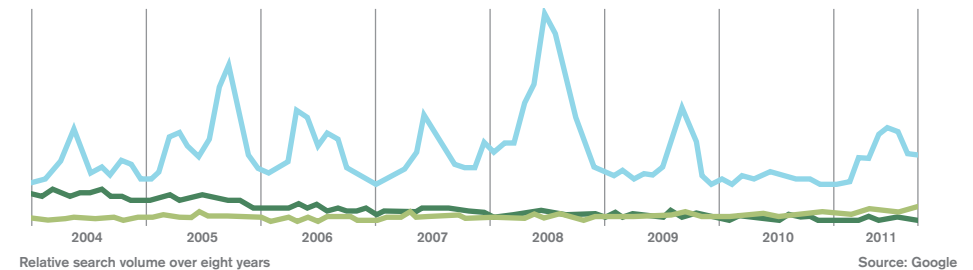
